Pierre Bustos Started Tattooing in 1997 in NYC, after attending The School of Visual Arts. located in NYC alongside some of the industry's top artists.





Hope you'll enjoy viewing my projects as much as I enjoyed working on them.



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







My techniques and inspiration have stemmed from my love for art. Gaining my Bachelor's in Fine Arts in drawing, illustration, and
